SUBJECT : Availability of the 2016 Drug Price Reference Index (DPRI) Electronic or Soft Copy

The 2016 (Fourth Edition) DPRI is now published electronically at www.dpri.doh.gov.ph and www.ncpam.doh.gov.ph. All government health facilities and agencies may now use the latest DPRI on their future drug procurement. The hard copy will be distributed once it is printed.

All DOH – ARMM and DOH Regional Offices are **requested to advise ALL of the** *Administrative* **mentioned facilities covered by their authority** as stipulated under the Administrative Order No. 51 s. 2015 issued on December 17, 2016 entitled “Guidelines in the Implementation of the Philippine Drug Price Reference Index (DPRI) to All Public Hospitals and Health Facilities” regarding this information.


III. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

“This Order is issued to provide technical guideline for all government agencies, government hospitals, hospitals managed by the DOH including specialty centers, government – owned and controlled hospital corporations, local government unit hospitals and all other types’ government hospitals, in implementing the DPRI as the unified pricing system for the procurement of medicines in the public sector.”
